Show conditions

- 1. All exhibits are to be staged between 9.00 and 10.30 am.
- Entries are free and there is no limit to the number of entries from any exhibitor, except class 49 where there may be one entry per school year group.
- 3. Exhibitors are to supply their own containers (green bottles are preferred for dahlia staging).
- 4. The judges' decisions shall be final.
- First, second and third prize cards will be awarded in each class unless there are insufficient entries.
- Exhibitors are not required to be a member of the Hobart Horticultural Society or the Dahlia Section.
- 7. Each entry must be accompanied by an exhibitor's entry card placed face down - these will be available at the show venue. Dahlia exhibitors will be included in the existing registration system, if not already.
- 8. All persons must leave the hall by 10.30am to allow judging.
- In the pot plant section, exhibits must have been in the possession of the exhibitor for at least six months.
- 10. All staged material must be collected by the exhibitor (or a nominee thereof) at the pack up time between 4.30 and 5pm.

Definitions

- 1. Distinct all different varieties
- 2. NND not necessarily distinct
- 3. Container/basket/bowl any vessel which for the purpose of showing is able to contain water without leaking
